notes

our first-ever true "gsm" blend. the nose delivers equal parts red (strawberry and raspberry) and blue (blackberry) fruit - along with spice, tobacco and dirt. the tannins (which help to frame the fruit and spice) keep the finish nice and dry. substantial yet soft at the same time.
